TVDSB’s Operational Plan 2020-2022-Updates

Goal One – Objective #1: Students are successful readers by the end of Grade 2.

Here’s How: Fundraising Requests for Next Year: HearBuilder Licenses - \$299/yr for 40 licenses; school-wide Reading A to Z license and student licenses of Raz Kids – approx. \$800

Goal One – Objective #2: Students apply knowledge of numbers and operations to solve math problems in everyday life.

School Improvement

SIPSAWs: We are finalizing our school goals that will take us through the rest of the year and into next year.

Literacy Goal: Students will improve their reading fluency (EY/Primary) and reading comprehension (Junior/Intermediate).

Numeracy Goal: Students will improve their math fluency (additive and multiplicative thinking). OR Students will improve their flexibility with number.

EQAO: Gr. 3s and 6s will be participating in EQAO this year and it will be online. As this is new, teachers, LST, and school Admin are currently learning about what this will look like.
