2. Staffing

2. CCAT

- All our Grade 3s will be completing CCAT over the next few weeks it's a standardized test that looks at problem-solving, critical thinking, reasoning, processing, etc. It helps us look at and better understand HOW our students learn. It is not a "curriculum" knowledge test and these results are shared only with the school team and individual caregivers.

Goal One – Objective #1: Students are successful readers by the end of Grade 2. *Here's How*: Our current goal is focused on reading fluency and comprehension using the strategy Shared Reading/Think-Alouds. *Here is how each division is working on this goal*:
